Priest (wearing a violet stole): Our help is in the name of the Lord.

Response: Who made heaven and earth.

O <u>salt</u>, creature of God, I <u>exorcise</u> you by the living + God, by the true + God, by the holy + God, by the God who ordered you to be poured into the water by Eliseus the prophet, so that its life-giving powers might be restored. I exorcise you so that you may become a means of salvation for believers, that you may bring health of soul and body to all who make use of you, and that you may put to flight and drive away from the places where you are sprinkled; every apparition, villainy, turn of devilish deceit, and every unclean spirit; adjured by him who will come to judge the living and the dead and the world by fire.

Response: Amen.

Let us pray.

Almighty and everlasting God, we humbly implore You, in Your immeasurable kindness and love, to bless + this salt which You created and gave to the use of mankind, so that it may become a source of health for the minds and bodies of all who make use of it. May it rid whatever it touches or sprinkles of all uncleanness, and protect it from every assault of evil spirits. Through our Lord, Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever.

Response: Amen.

O <u>water</u>, creature of God, I <u>exorcise</u> you in the name of God the Father + Almighty, and in the name of Jesus + Christ His Son, our Lord, and in the power of the Holy + Spirit. I exorcise you so that you may put to flight all the power of the enemy, and be able to root out and supplant that enemy with his apostate angels, through the power of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will come to judge the living and the dead and the world by fire.

Response: Amen.

Let us pray.

O God, for the salvation of mankind, You built Your greatest mysteries on this substance, water. In Your kindness, hear our prayers and pour down the power of Your blessing + into this element, made ready for many kinds of purifications. May this, Your creature, become an agent of divine grace in the service of Your mysteries, to drive away evil spirits and dispel sickness, so that everything in the homes and other buildings of the faithful that is sprinkled with this water, may be rid of all uncleanness and freed from every harm. Let no breath of infection and no disease-bearing air remain in these places. May the wiles of the lurking enemy prove of no avail. Let whatever might menace the safety and peace of those who live here be put to flight by the sprinkling of this water, so that the health obtained by calling upon Your holy name, may be made secure against all attack. Through our Lord, Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever.

Response: Amen. Over →

Here the priest pours the blessed salt into the blessed water in the form of a cross, saying:

May a mixture of salt and water now be made, in the name of the Father, + and of the + Son, and of the Holy Spirit. +

Response: Amen.

Priest: The Lord be with you.

Response: And with your spirit.

Let us pray.

O God, Creator unconquerable, invincible King, Victor ever-glorious, You hold in check the forces bent on dominating us. Exorcism of a Church (or an Area of Worship)

Priest: Our help is in the name of the Lord. **Response:** Who made heaven and earth.

Priest: The Lord be with you. **Response:** And with your spirit.

Priest: Let us pray.

I exorcise you, every unclean spirit, in the name of God the Father + Almighty, and in the name of His Son, Jesus + Christ, our Lord and Judge, and in the strength of the Holy + Spirit, that you may now depart from this Church (area of worship), so that those who worship here might become temples of the living God, and that the Holy Spirit might dwell within them. Through the same Christ our Lord, Who will come to judge the living and the dead and the world by fire.

Response: Amen.

[Now sprinkle the holy water around the house; it has a deliverance or exorcism in it.]

Blessing of Candles

Priest: Our help is in the name of the Lord. **Response:** Who made heaven and earth.

Priest: The Lord be with you. **Response:** And with your spirit.

Priest:

Let us pray. O Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, bless + these candles at our request. By the power of the holy cross, + bestow a heavenly blessing on them, O Lord, Who did give them to mankind to dispel the gloom. Empowered with the seal of Your holy cross, + let the spirits of darkness depart trembling and fly in fear from all places where their light shines, and never more disturb nor molest those who serve You, the almighty God, Who lives and reigns forevermore.

Response: Amen.

[Now sprinkle the candles with holy water.]

Blessing of a Sacred Statue or Picture or Image

Priest: Our help is in the name of the Lord. **Response:** Who made heaven and earth.

Priest: The Lord be with you. **Response:** And with your spirit.

Let us pray.

Almighty, everlasting God, You do not forbid us to represent your saints in stone or paint (or wood, bronze, etc.), so that, as often as we look upon their likenesses with the eyes of the body, we may with the eyes of the mind meditate upon their holiness and be led to imitate their deeds. In Your kindness, we beg You to bless + and sanctify + this picture (statue), meant to honor and call to mind Your only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ (or the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of our Lord Jesus Christ, or Blessed N., your apostle, or martyr, or bishop, or confessor, or virgin). May all who in its presence humbly strive to serve and honor Your only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ (or the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of our Lord Jesus Christ, or confessor, or virgin), by his/(her) merits and intercession, gain from You grace in the present life and eternal glory in the life to come. Through (the same) Christ our Lord.

Response: Amen.

[Now sprinkle the image(s) with holy water.]

Solemn Blessing of a Cross

Priest: Our help is in the name of the Lord. **Response**: Who made heaven and earth.

Priest: The Lord be with you. **Response:** May He also be with you.

Let us pray. Holy Lord, almighty Father, everlasting God, be pleased to bless + this cross, that it may be a saving help to mankind. Let it be the support of faith, an encouragement to good works, the redemption of souls; and let it be consolation, protection, and a shield against the cruel darts of the enemy; through Christ our Lord. **Response:** Amen.

Let us pray. Lord Jesus Christ, bless + this cross by which you snatched the world from Satan's grasp, and on which you overcame by your suffering the tempter to sin, who rejoiced in the first man's fall in eating of the forbidden tree. [Here it is sprinkled with holy water.] May this cross be hallowed in the name of the Father, + and of the Son, + and of the Holy + Spirit; and may all who kneel and pray before this cross in honor of our Lord find health in body and soul; through Christ our Lord.

Response: Amen. [After this the priest, kneeling before the cross, devoutly venerates and kisses it, and others may do likewise.]

Blessing of the St. Benedict Medal

Priest: Our help is in the name of the Lord. **Response:** Who made heaven and earth.

In the name of God the Father + almighty, Who made heaven and earth, the seas and all that is in them, I exorcise these medals against the power and attacks of the evil one. May all who use these medals devoutly be blessed with health of soul and body. In the name of the Father + almighty, of the Son + Jesus Christ our Lord, and of the Holy + Spirit the Paraclete, and in the love of the same Lord Jesus Christ Who will come on the last day to judge the living and the dead, and the world by fire. Amen.

Let us pray. Almighty God, the boundless source of all good things, we humbly ask that, through the intercession of Saint Benedict, You pour out Your blessings + upon these medals. May those who use them devoutly and earnestly strive to perform good works, be blessed by You with health of soul and body, the grace of a holy life, and remission of the temporal punishment due to sin.

May they also, with the help of Your merciful love, resist the temptation of the evil one and strive to exercise true charity and justice toward all, so that one day they may appear sinless and holy in Your sight. This we ask though Christ our Lord. Amen.

Blessing of Rosaries

The priest wears a white stole if possible.

Priest: Our help is in the name of the Lord. **Response:** Who made heaven and earth.

Priest: The Lord be with you. **Response:** And with your spirit.

Let us pray.

Almighty and merciful God, on account of Your very great love for us, You willed that Your only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, should come down from heaven to earth, and at the angel's message take flesh in the most sacred womb of Our Lady, the most blessed Virgin Mary; submit to death on the cross, and then rise gloriously from the dead on the third day, in order to deliver us from Satan's tyranny. We humbly beg You, in Your boundless goodness to bless + and to sanctify + these Rosaries (or this Rosary), which Your faithful Church has consecrated to the honor and praise of the Mother of your Son. And may this blessing remain upon this place (house) and upon those who live here, now and forever and ever. Amen.

[Now sprinkle the holy water around the house; it has a deliverance or exorcism in it.]

Blessing of a House

May the Almighty and Merciful God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit bless and protect us.

O most sweet Lord Jesus Christ, almighty King of heaven and earth, Son of David, Jesus of Nazareth, crucified for us: Son of the Living God, have mercy on this house, guard those who dwell here.

May Your Divine blessing accompany them everywhere; may the Holy Spirit enlighten their minds and hearts, and may His power work through them in every place.

May He bless everything that is found in this house, those who enter and those who leave, and may His blessing of the Most Holy Trinity guard them from evil, so that no misfortune may come near them.

(Prayer said as priest censes the offerings): May this incense blessed by You, arise before You, O Lord, and may Your mercy come down upon us.

(Prayer said as priest censes the altar): Let my prayer, O Lord, come like incense before You; the lifting up of my hands, like the evening sacrifice. O Lord, set a watch before my mouth, a guard at the door of my lips. Let not my heart incline to the evil of engaging in deeds of wickedness.

Rite for the Blessing and Investiture of the Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel

To obtain the fullest possible benefits from the Brown Scapular devotion, one must be validly invested (sometimes called "enrolled") in the Brown Scapular by a priest who possesses the faculties (usually a Carmelite, Dominican or Franciscan), using a scapular blessed by the same or any other priest. After proper enrollment in the Scapular, a person need not have subsequent scapulars blessed. Once enrolled you are enrolled until death.

Priest: Show us, O Lord, Thy mercy.

Respondent: And grant us Thy salvation.

After the investiture, the priest continues:

I, by the power vested in me, admit you to participate in all the spiritual benefits obtained through the mercy of Jesus Christ by the Religious Order of Mount Carmel. In the name of the Father † and of the Son † and of the Holy Ghost †. Amen. May God Almighty, the Creator of Heaven and earth, bless † you, He who has deigned to join you to the confraternity of the Blessed Virgin of Mount Carmel; we beseech Her to crush the head of the ancient serpent so that you may enter into possession of your eternal heritage through Christ our Lord.

Respondent: Amen.

Blessing and Investiture with the Miraculous Medal

[Priest vests in surplice and white stole]

Priest: Our help is in the name of the Lord Respondant: Who made heaven and earth.

P: The Lord be with you. R: And with your spirit.

P: Let us pray.

Almighty and merciful God, Who by the many appearances on earth of the Immaculate Virgin Mary were pleased to work miracles again and again for the salvation of souls; kindly pour out Your blessing + on this medal, so that all who devoutly wear it and reverence it may experience the patronage of Mary Immaculate and obtain mercy from You; through Christ our Lord. Amen.

[Priest sprinkles Miraculous Medal(s) with Holy Water, then presents it to person(s) saying:] Take this holy medal; wear it with faith, and handle it with due devotion, so that the holy and Immaculate Queen of Heaven may protect and defend you. And as she is ever ready to renew her wondrous acts of kindness, may she obtain for you in her mercy whatever you humbly ask of God, so that both in life and in death, you may rest happily in her motherly embrace. Amen.

At the end of the principal Mass on the feast of St. John, Apostle and Evangelist, after the last Gospel, the priest, retaining all vestments except the maniple, blesses wine brought by the people. This is done in memory and in honor of St. John, who drank without any ill effects the poisoned wine offered to him by his enemies.

P: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

All: Who made heaven and earth.

P: The Lord be with you.

All: May He also be with you.

Let us pray.

If it please You, Lord God, bless + and consecrate + this vessel of wine (or any other beverage) by the power of Your right hand; and grant that, through the merits of St. John, apostle and evangelist, all Your faithful who drink of it may find it a help and a protection. As the blessed John drank the poisoned potion without any ill effects, so may all who today drink the blessed wine in his honor be delivered from poisoning and similar harmful things. And as they offer themselves body and soul to You, may they obtain pardon of all their sins; through Christ our Lord. All: Amen.

Lord, bless + this creature drink, so that it may be a health-giving medicine to all who use it; and grant by Your grace that all who taste of it may enjoy bodily and spiritual health in calling on Your holy name; through Christ our Lord. All: Amen.

May the blessing of Almighty God, Father, Son, + and Holy Spirit, come on this wine (or any other beverage) and remain always. All: Amen.
