
Chaplet of the Holy Face

Prayer Intentions

- Sundays: Your intention.
- Mondays: For the schools in Colorado to thrive in the truth and for all attacks against truth to be disabled; we pray especially for: St. Joseph, St. John the Evangelist (Loveland), St. John Paul II (Windsor), Ascent (Windsor), all Liberty Common and Ridgeview schools.
- <u>Tuesdays:</u> For all who live in Colorado who are against the sanctity of life, especially elected officials, lawmakers, and judges:
 - for their conversion; that God will illuminate their consciences so that they realize the evil they are doing and have done;
 - that they will fight each other in such a way that their evil works are brought to an end. [This is our response to Amendment 79 passing.]
- Wednesdays: Your intention.
- <u>Thursdays:</u> That Marisol Health will thrive and that Planned Parenthood would be closed down.
- <u>Fridays:</u> For the end of human trafficking in Colorado; for the conversion of the traffickers, and healing for those who have been trafficked.

Remember the power of the words of Sacred Scripture as you pray:

1 Maccabees 3:13-22, especially verses 19 & 22

19 It is not on the size of the army that victory in battle depends, but strength comes from Heaven.

22 He Himself [God] will crush them before us; as for you, do not be afraid of them.

Leviticus 26:3-8, especially verses 6 & 8

6 And I will give peace in the land, and you shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid; and I will remove evil beasts from the land, and the sword shall not go through your land.

8 Five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall chase ten thousand; and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword.

Judges 6-8 Summary

The Midianites were oppressing Israel. The Midianites were a nomadic Arabic tribe that were known for causing havoc on other tribes, especially the Israelites. God chose Gideon to defeat the oppressors. Gideon rounded up 32,000 men to fight. The Lord had Gideon test the men. 22,000 quit before the big battle (Judges 7:2-3). The Lord had Gideon test the remaining 10,000, and Gideon eliminated another 9,700 men. So, Gideon's army was down to 300 (Judges 7:4-7). The Lord was doing this so that Gideon's army could not claim that they won by their own power.

On the day of the big battle, after Gideon's men blew 300 trumpets, God caused the Midianites to fight each other, and many were killed by their own countrymen! (Judges 7:19-23). At least 120,000 were killed.
